



Prof. J.P. Kennedy (Short Biography):

Prof. Kennedy holds a Ph.D. from the U. of Vienna, Austria, an M.B.A. from Rutgers U., and an Honorary Doctorate from Kossuth Lajos U., Debrecen, Hungary. Accomplishments include over 650 publications (incl. three books) and 83 issued U.S. patents (several licensed). He has received numerous awards, such as the Morley Award, Doebereiner Medaille, ACS Award Polymer Chemistry, ACS Award Applied Polymer Chemistry. George S. Whitby Award, NSF Special Creativity Award (twice), Award for Distinguished Service in Polymer Science (Society of Polymer Science, Japan), etc. In 1993, he was elected external member of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences. Prof. Kennedy is best known for his contributions to cationic olefin polymerization, which include the living cationic polymerization of isobutylene and the controlled synthesis of "Macromolecular Engineering" was coined by him. His interests of recent years include the design and synthesis of biomaterials. Prof. Kennedy has advised/mentored more than 130 students/postdocs/visiting scientists. In 1959 he was appointed Guest Professor in Polymer Science at Kyoto U., Japan, 1970 Professor of Polymer Science and 1980 Distinguished Professor of Polymer Science and University of Akron.
